Port Windsor is governed by a Board of Directors. The Board makes independent and timely decisions based on strategic plans with a focus on the operational needs of port users and is guided by a vision for on-going prosperity for Windsor-Essex's economy, environment and community.

We are particularly interested in individuals who have experience with board governance, strategic planning, risk management, financial performance leadership, government/regulatory leadership, business development, and senior executive leadership.
